Sports Premium Report 2018



PE is a vital part of the curriculum at Little Missenden.

Our sports premium is used to raise attainment and enjoyment of sport. Our objectives in spending our sports funding is as follows:

- Providing teachers with opportunities to observe high quality PE lessons taught by a qualified sports coach, raising standards in PE lessons.
- Provide the opportunity for our children to be taught by a qualified sports coach.
- Provide children with the opportunity to attend sports events and competitions with other schools, providing them with the opportunities to apply and develop their skills and increase their sporting confidence.

To achieve this we:

- Employ a qualified sports coach to teach in the school. He is also used to provide training for school staff.
- Funding participation at sports events, such as the Holmer Green Sports Partnership and the Small Schools Country Dance Festival.
- Employ (with the help of the PTA) a qualified Forest School teacher to ensure all children have access to half a term of Forest School.

The Impact on Pupil Participation and attainment leading to all pupils developing a healthy lifestyle is as follows:

- 100% of children in school receive 2 hours of quality PE provision within the curriculum.
- 100% of children are taught by a qualified sports coach.
- 100% of children attend regular sports festivals.
- 100% of children participate in a block of Forest School each year.
- Staff training increasing staff expertise in teaching the PE curriculum.
