Pupil Premium Report 2020



Pupil Premium is allocated to schools for children known to have been eligible for free school meals at any time in the last six years. This funding is used to help these children learn and make as much progress as possible. The Pupil Premium allocation is spent on providing academic support to increase progress and attainment or as a means of enriching pupils' learning or experiences.

Over the academic year 2019-20 the school has had no pupil premium children on roll.

In the past Pupil Premium funding has been spent on providing:

Action	Impact
Employment of staff to allow for small group or extra 1:1 tuition.	Monitoring showed that this intervention aided progress in many areas of the curriculum.
Providing specific resources to aid progress and raise achievement	This action has helped to support the curriculum and target specific needs, resulting in an increase in progress.
Access to the wider curriculum, including extra-curricular clubs and activities	This action resulted in an increase in confidence and self-esteem over the year.
Nurture group support – Training and employment of a TA to administer the group.	Monitoring by the Educational Psychologist's assistant and the TA showed that the confidence of children in this group had risen.
