

Dear Parents

To truly engage the children in what we are learning we really hope to use your child's interests to lead the topic choices, so if there are particular interests your child has, or you happen to be going on an exciting trip etc. please do share it with us so we can use the information in our planning.

Learning happens inside and outside in the early years, so children will have "free flow" between the areas. It means that the classroom is sometimes a little chilly so please ensure children always have jumpers/cardigans and coats and when weather demands it gloves and hats. The children also participate in a range of activitiesincluding; messy activities, playing in the mud kitchen, mixing paints, exploring a wide variety of sensory materials etc. We provide a pair of waterproof trousers; please can you provide a named pair of wellies that stay in school.

We enjoy sharing stories with the children on a daily basis and looking at non-fiction texts. We do recommend that you spend time-sharing books with your child at home, visiting libraries and allowing your child to observe you reading. This will help foster a love of books.

To provide a stimulating and engaging experience for the children there are many consumables that we use on a regular basis for example rice, shaving foam, bubble bath, flour, soil etc. We would be grateful for any contributions of the items listed. We will use a class notice board to share our wish list in future.
