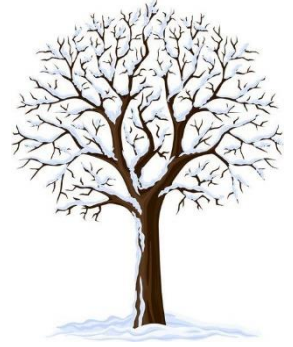

In Forest School we will be making bird feeders to go home. We have also been discussing animals that hibernate and made hedgehogs from playdough and clay.

OWL CLASS

In Literacy we have been looking at the story of “Going on a Bear Hunt” and have started writing our own version of the story. During our science sessions we are looking at season changes and the differences between winter and spring.

In art we are creating nature sculptures; looking at natural objects and animals then creating our own sculptures in clay and sketching them.

In our wellbeing sessions, Year 1 visited the village play area in Forest School – we explored the seasonal changes on our walk and completed a scavenger hunt, then the children had the opportunity to play on the new equipment. Year 2 have had Yoga with Mrs Ellis and have practised yoga poses and made coloured dreamcatchers.
