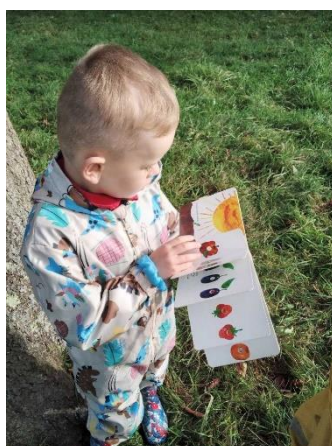
# Class News
