Thursday 11th December

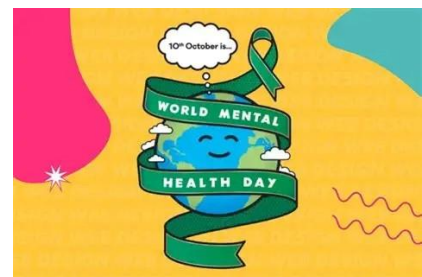
