Wraparound Care and Clubs Pick-Up

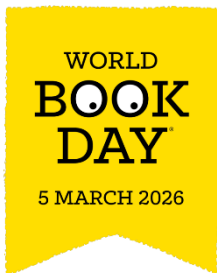

It was great to see so many of our parents supporting the event, we are sure you'll agree the children sang beautifully!

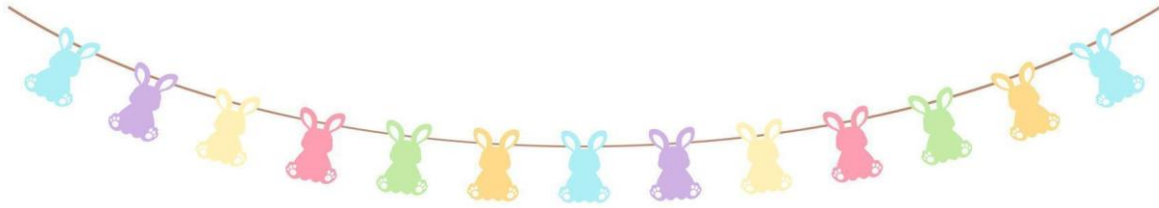
Owl class also enjoyed learning to play the violin during their workshop on Thursday.
