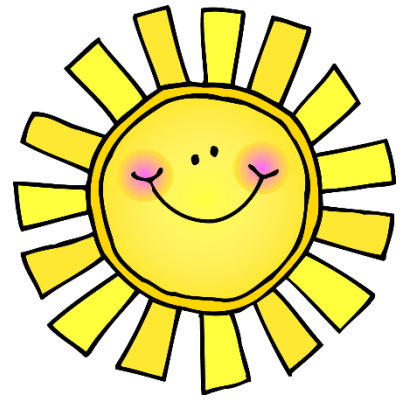




Newsletter: Friday 26 June
