Little Missenden School prides itself on being a central part of the community. We have strong ties with St John the Baptist Church in the village and pupils participate in regular services at the church.



Every year, pupils distribute Harvest gifts to local villagers, hold an Easter parade at the church and enter the annual Village Show. Local residents are always invited to attend the school's Christmas Nativity play, which all the children take part in.

These close links give our pupils pride in their school and a sense of belonging to a wider community.
